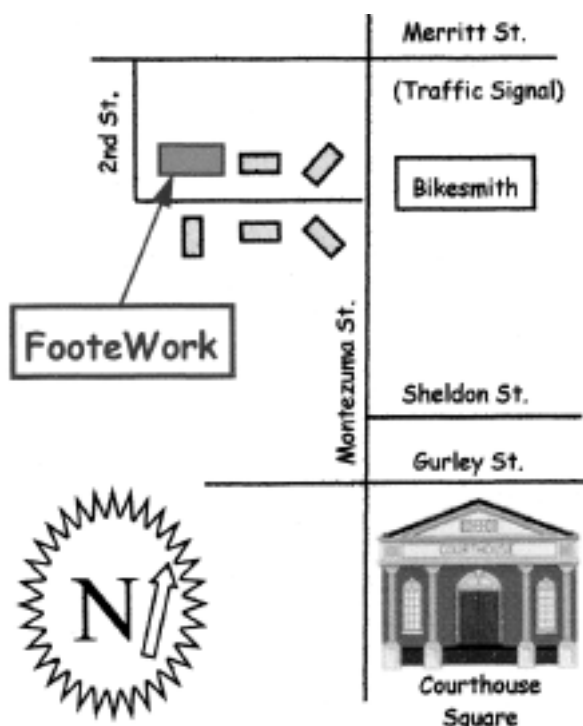

## Time to get that boat ready for summer.

1. Does your boat and trailer have current regis-

tration. Nothing spoils a trip like getting stopped by Game & Fish or DPS for expired registration.

2. Make sure your trailer is in tip top condition. Some things to check out:

Are all of your lights in working order?

Have you checked your wheel bearings to make sure they're lubricated?

Have you checked your tires? Things to look for: they're in-

flated properly, have good tread and no sign of dry rot.

Also, when was the last time you checked the air pressure in your spare tire?

3. Don't forget about your safety equipment. Are they all up to date and in good working order? Lifejackets, ropes, flares, tires, etc.

4. Enjoy yourself!
