Increase Your GVW if needed.... Authorities are cracking down

Gross Vehicle weight is not something that many people think about. However; many of you that drive larger trucks, service body vehicles, and any vehicle with signage, should check what weight you have your vehicle registered at.

When registering your vehicle it should be **registered for the weight that it will weigh when fully loaded.**

Law enforcement has recently began to crack down on vehicles with incorrect weight registrations by using their portable scales to weigh vehicles on local roads and highways where there are no permanent weigh stations. They are serious about infractions.

If you're unsure about the weight that your vehicle is currently registered at, please give us a call and we can verify what weight your vehicles are currently registered at.

Hunting Season is Upon Us!

There is still a good portion of hunting season left and even though it is colder out, many of you are still using your ATV'S. The Game & Fish Department is hiring more enforcement officers every month to watch for riders without the new OHV tags and proper registration. We want to remind you to come in and let us help with your OHV and registration needs before you head out for your hunt. You might even qualify for reduced registration.

What is SR-22 Insurance?

Did you know that if you do not maintain constant insurance coverage, you may be required to obtain an SR-22? An SR-22 insurance policy is known as either a "High-Risk" insurance policy or as a "Financial Responsibility" insurance. The SR-22 policy must be obtained through your insurance company and must be maintained for three years on the vehicle that has had a lapse of insurance.

In the event you need to drop insurance on a vehicle, be sure to come by our office to file a de-insured form so that you will not need the SR-22 later. Also, if you receive a letter from MVD about issues with insurance coverage, do not ignore this letter. Come by our office as soon as possible, and for a nominal fee, we will immediately file the correct paperwork to prevent your record from being suspended.

If you have any other questions regarding insurance registration suspension please feel free to call or come by either of our offices.

Preventing Fraud

There are two easy ways to prevent fraud when you sell your vehicle. First, when you sell a vehicle you should always take the license plate(s) off of the vehicle. These license plate(s) belong to you and you may use these plates on another vehicle or apply for a plate credit/refund. If you decide not to re-use the license plates please recycle them by turning it into us. Do not throw the plates away. We have had reports of customers who threw away a license plate, only to find out later the plate was used fraudulently.

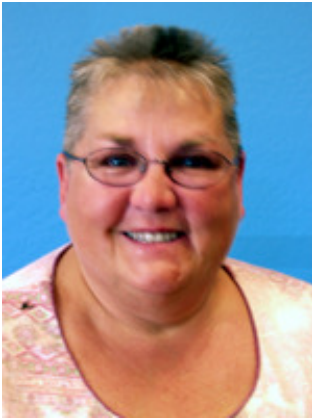
Second, by filling out a sold notice, it notifies the state that you sold the vehicle and removes all liability from your name. It does not change ownership. Ownership transfer happens when the new owner actually transfers ownership by changing the name on the title.

Come by and see us at either location after selling your vehicle and our fast and friendly staff can help you take care of the paperwork.
